Responsibilities of Clerk-Treasurer

The Clerk-Treasurer processes the receipts and expenditures of all city money; prescribes the payroll for the city; determines the manner in which vendors, officers and employees are paid; manages all city financial accounts; makes all investments on behalf of the City; prepares the budget estimates of revenue, financial statements and the proposed tax rate; manages all city records; serves as the clerk of the City Council and Board of Public Works by preparing agendas, recording proceedings and maintaining custody of records.

- Contracts between the City and other public agencies
- Minutes of all public meetings conducted by the Board of Public Works and the City Council
