**EXECUTIVE ORDER
JB-2020-10**

WHEREAS, as Mayor of the City of Carmel, Indiana ("Carmel"), I issued Executive Order JB-2009-3 on November 16, 2009, establishing the Mayor's Advisory Commission on Human Relations consisting of a volunteer body of up to nine (9) members appointed by me, which members shall represent a cross-section of the citizens of Carmel and be willing to actively promote and support the Commission's mission and goals; and


WHEREAS, the Commission has benefitted from the guidance, experience and unique role of the city's Chief of Police and Director of Human Resources during their faithful attendance at quarterly and special meetings of the Commission and at Commission events and city meetings involving social issues; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to amend JB-2009-3 to include the city's Chief of Police and Director of Human Resources as ex-officio members of the Commission. These two ex-officio members do not count towards the total number of up to nine (9) appointed members of the Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power and authority granted to me as Mayor of the City of Carmel, Indiana, I, James Brainard, do hereby declare and order that,

1. Effective immediately the Director of Human Resources will serve as an ex-officio member of the Mayor's Advisory Commission on Human Relations.
2. Effective immediately the Chief of Police will serve as an ex-officio member of the Mayor's Advisory Commission on Human Relations.
